Aloha ULS Parents/Guardians,

Due to circumstances out of our control, our plan to return to campus for in-person learning will not be possible at this time. On Tuesday, December 22, 2020, we received notification from the University of Hawai'i that our return to campus for the Spring Semester 2021 was denied. The University of Hawai'i campus is limited to in-person only when absolutely necessary (95% of courses are online) and will remain closed to the public until further notice.

We are very disappointed in this decision. While we have made every effort to return in the safest possible manner, including implementing a new health check app, unfortunately, we are not able to do so at this time.

Despite this news, ULS administration, faculty and staff remain committed to providing your child with a quality education under these difficult circumstances. There will be an updated ULS Spring Semester 2021 Plan that includes the distance learning models and schedules for grades K-12. We will be sharing this with the entire ULS community in the coming days. The spring semester will begin on Tuesday, January 5, 2021.

We are appreciative of your patience and support as we navigate through these ever challenging times.
