### **ULS Student Travel**

As a reminder, parents are to notify the school anytime your child(ren) will be traveling off island whether during the school week, on weekends, holidays or breaks. ULS requires that any student who travels off island for any reason at any time, must be cleared by the school in order to return per our health and safety protocols outlined in our Student/Parent Handbook. ULS is currently following the state's Safe Travels Program, however, ULS may add additional measures to our travel protocol if we deem it necessary. Refer to page 37 in our handbook for the ULS travel protocols.

Please email [attendance@universitylaboratoryschool.org](mailto:attendance@universitylaboratoryschool.org) to inform us of any travel plans. We will then notify you of the return to school protocols for travel.

### **Health and Safety**

We would like to remind all parents to please keep your child at home when not feeling well. If there are people in your household that are sick (siblings, parents, or extended family members), keep your child home even though they themselves may not be sick. Email attendance to report the situation and absence. We will respond with our clearance protocols.

It is also important that when reporting an absence you provide enough information to help us determine your child's clearance protocols. If not, the office staff will have to follow up with you and that may delay your child's clearance to return to school. Refer to pages 10-11 in the student/parent handbook for our Return to School protocols.

Students should not come to school if they or someone in their household is awaiting COVID-19 test results due to being exposed to a positive case. Notify the school right away by emailing [health@universitylaboratoryschool.org](mailto:health@universitylaboratoryschool.org) at any time (nights, weekends, week days) and we will respond with our COVID-19 protocols.

We strongly encourage all families to read through the [ULS Student/Parent Handbook](#) for up-to-date information on school policies and procedures in regards to health and safety.

### **Visitation to Campus**

ULS is currently following the state mandate regarding the restriction of outside visitors and contractors to state institutions without prior clearance. For ULS, prior clearance means completing the LumiSight health check-in and providing proof of vaccination or negative test result. **If parents need to come to campus for any reason, please contact the school office at 956-7833 before coming to campus.** The office staff will assist you with the clearance protocols. As a reminder, only vehicles with the proper permit are allowed to park in the parking lot.

### **LumiSight**

We continue to ask for your help and cooperation in completing the **LumiSight health check in** for your child(ren) each morning. LumiSight is an important tool in keeping our students, faculty and staff safe and healthy so that we can come to school for in-person learning.

### **First Quarter Report Cards**

This year ULS is implementing a quarter system where students will receive official report cards for each quarter and semester. The first quarter ends on Friday, October 8, 2021. Report cards will be mailed home the week of October 25, 2021.

### **K-5 Virtual Parent Conferences**

This year K-5 virtual parent conferences will be held on October 25-28, 2021. On these days, school will be done at 12:00pm following their lunch period. Pick-up will be on Metcalf street. Conferences will be held in the afternoon. K-5 teachers will be reaching out to parents in the coming weeks to schedule conferences. Please be on the lookout for that communication.

### **PSAT Testing for Grades 10-11**

Students in grades 10-11 will be taking the PSAT in school on Tuesday, October 26, 2021. In the coming weeks, information will be shared with students on how best to prepare for the test and what tools are necessary to bring on the day of the test. Parents received a letter via email with more information on the test.

The PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/ National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) provides great practice for the SAT®. Students will get personalized feedback on their skills to help them improve before taking the SAT. For juniors, the PSAT/NMSQT offers them the opportunity to qualify for scholarships that can help pay for college. The PSAT/NMSQT also connects students with colleges and universities across the country.

### **Meal Program (Lunch only) at School**

ULS continues to provide students with a free lunch on in-person school days. If you already have signed up for the school meal, you do not need to contact the school each month asking to re-apply as your child is approved and will continue to have lunch at school each day. ### **ULS Athletics**
