The University Laboratory School, seeks candidates for the position of Vice Principal for the 2022-2023 school year.

The Vice Principal will assist the Principal in the overall administration of the school functions, including but not limited to the development, implementation, organizational, alignment, and evaluation of our comprehensive educational program, student support services, student discipline program, school success program, and other initiatives to improve the quality of education of all students and employees at the University Laboratory School.

The duties of the Vice-Principal include but are not limited to: communicate with families; address academic, behavioral, and social issues; implement and enforce the policies and procedures, statutory requirements, administrative rules and regulations; respond to and report on student issues and concerns; ensure student safety; schedule and participate in parent-teacher conferences as needed; monitor student growth and progress; plan and implement meetings with teachers; oversee the development of student success plans for all students; serve as a member of the administrative team; serve as administrator in the absence of the principal; and other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Master's degree in education, educational administration or leadership, or related field
- Professional experience with responsibilities for teaching, mentoring, and/or school administration in K–12 education
- Knowledge of and experience in implementing and evaluating effective classroom management, student-centered learning and cooperative/collaborative instructional strategies
- Knowledge of the principles, concepts, and issues of effective research-based practices in K–12 education and charter school administration
- Demonstrated ability to develop short- and long-term plans of action
- Demonstrated ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with internal and external organizations, groups, individuals, students, parents, and teachers.
- Ability to perform assigned duties in accordance with applicable guidelines, policies, and procedures.
- Proficiency in Google Apps for Education Suite, and online meeting software
- Ability to effectively communicate orally and in writing to students, parents, administration, teachers, and the community in a professional manner

- Experience in designing and implementing curriculum for, and/or teaching in a multicultural and diverse learning environment
- Experience teaching and conducting research in an educational research environment
- Knowledge of and ability to digest and report on current theories of teaching, learning, curriculum, instruction, and assessment to a wide range of audiences and stakeholders
