<u>Updates.</u> Panorama Student Perception Survey - November 30; School Quality Parent Survey - January 2024; FY2023-2024 Projected Per Pupil is \$10,497.35 (includes a one-time transfer of \$5,000,000 of discretionary funds from the governor that may not be sustained in subsequent years; includes a deduction for payment of the claims management services for workers' compensation by the Department of Human Resources Development (DHRD) for FY2022-2023. The total amount charged by DHRD for these services was \$86,354.00; this resulted in a per pupil charge of \$6.82 to each charter school; per pupil amount should be considered as a projected amount as charter school funding is subject to restriction or reduction by the governor at any time for the remainder of this fiscal year); Hawaii Keiki: Healthy and Ready to Learn Program <u>Hawaii Pacific Model United Nations Conference:</u> PacMUN is the largest and most competitive conference in the Hawaii MUN circuit. ULS was competing against schools from all over the state, as well as schools that flew in from Silicon Valley, Vancouver, and Chicago. Corina L. (Grade 11) won Best Delegate representing Belarus in the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA); Harshith B. (Grade 11) won Honorable Mention representing China in the United Nations Refugee Agency (UNHCR); and, Dava W. (Grade 10) won Verbal Commendation representing Micronesia in the United Nations Refugee Agency (UNHCR).
